

# We believe that in 2016 God is inviting us to renew our lives, our city and our world by:

#### **Action 1: Joining in God's Redemptive Work**

God is at work all around us. We will join in that work of renewal by:

- Encouraging the continued formation of Missional Communities, who share rhythms of life and unite around a common purpose.
- Pursuing opportunities to address racial reconciliation by partnering with other churches that are different than us and/or are further down the road on this journey.
- Reinvesting locally by offering CREATE (a week long art camp) in the summer of 2016
- Partnering with the Alger Heights Collaborative to empower and serve neighbors in SE Grand Rapids
- Discerning what relationship(s) God wants us to develop in order to be a part of God's global work.

#### **Action 2: Offering Lavish Hospitality and Care**

God is open-armed, always ready to receive all people. We will reflect that hospitality and care by:

- Creating a welcoming environment on Sunday morning that allows us to add to our family
- Developing clear steps anyone can take to become more connected.
- Creating a process that helps us respond wisely to the needs of those at the Branch and in the community.

### **Action 3: Transforming the Next Generation**

In God's family, children are held up and valued. We will invest in the next generation by:

- ▶ Hiring a BranchKids Director who will lead our efforts around growing and deepening our Sunday ministry to children birth-5th grade.
- Continuing to provide ways for kids to meaningfully give their gifts on Sunday and beyond.
- Investing in those leaders who are serving and leading our middle school students.

### **Action 4: Equipping and Releasing People**

God calls the church to equip and release its people. We will be obedient to this call by:

- Creating sermon series and small group opportunities to spur growth.
- Continuing to refine huddle our main tool for developing and equipping leaders.
- Inviting more voices, gifts and creativity into our corporate worship.
